DOS VALLES VIEWPOINT EXCURSION

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

We will head for the Lagunillas Ski Resort, located at 2,200 meters above sea level. From this point we will start our 30-minute trek through a gentle slope leading us to a beautiful plain located at 2.425 meters above sea level, a mandatory stop where we will take a break while enjoying the stunning view of San Lorenzo Hill. From here we begin taking height to reach the peak of Morro Bayo at 2,665 meters above sea level, the highest point we will reach on the excursion having the opportunity to see different types of mountain birds, in addition to the lovely peaks around the area.

The route is followed through the San Francisco de Lagunillas y Quillayal Sanctuary including about 14,000 Ha. and different trails. This tour can be taken at any time of the year, even in winter adding snowshoes to our trek, if necessary.

TRES ESTEROS EXCURSION

From this point, we will start our trek along a beautiful trail while enjoying part of the Likan Hill geositio (place of geological interest) where traces belonging to the Chiquillan culture have been found.

APAREJO VALLEY EXCURSION

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

We will head for El Yeso Valley (Valle del Yeso), a lovely mountain valley surrounded by mountains rising high above 4,000 meters above sea level. On the route we will be able to see the stunning El Yeso Reservoir (Embalse del Yeso), in addition to hanging glaciers covered with existing mountain minerals of numerous colors.

Location and Season

The route is followed through a great part of the Cajón del Maipo to merge with El Yeso Valley (Valle del Yeso). We will go into this Valley for about 1 hour to arrive on foot and start our trek. It is posible to take this tour only in the spring - summer season, as the access is restricted when the first snowfalls come up due to ice and snow conditions on the route.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides, will visit this lovely Andean valley. A guide will stay beside them all the way providing safety and relevant information about what is taking place in situ while describing the landscape.

MESÓN ALTO HORSEBACK RIDE

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

We will head for El Yeso Valley (Valle del Yeso), a lovely mountain valley surrounded by mountains rising high above 4,000 meters above sea level. We will reach The Muleteer's Grocery Store (Pulpería del Arriero). In this place, technical information about horseback rides will be provided while learning about what life is like among mountain muleteers.

The route is followed along an old and wide mining road.

Participants

Location and Season

The route is followed through a great part of the Cajón del Maipo to merge with El Yeso Valley (Valle del Yeso). We will go into this valley for about 30 minutes along a paved road to end by van at the Muleteer's Grocery Store (Pulpería del Arriero), the starting point of our horseback ride. We will go through the Cortaderas Valley (Valle de las Cortaderas) ending in a lovely plain with views of Meson Alto Glacier (Glaciar Mesón Alto), El Morado Hill and others. It is possible to take this tour only in the spring - summer season, as the access is restricted when the first snowfalls come up due to ice and snow conditions on the route.

Booking at least 72 hours in advance.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides and muleteers, will learn about a great part of the life among mountain muleteers, as well as getting to know much of the Cajón del Maipo geological heritage in situ. A guide and a muleteer will stay beside them all the way providing safety and relevant information about what is taking place in situ while sharing mountain tales.

BLACK SNOWS GLACIER TREKKING

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

We will start the tour from our Hotel heading east, after 80 km (2 hours) we will reach the end of Colina Valley (Valle de Colina), very close to the border with Argentina where the famous Valley Hotsprings (Termas del Valle) are located. From this place we will begin our trek heading east towards the White Snows border crossing (paso fronterizo Nieves Negras). The route is followed through a marked trail providing lovely postcards, such as the mountain plains and mountains rising high above 3,500 meters above sea level. After a 3-kilometer trek, we will go over the Volcano River to finally reach the Black Snows Viewpoint (Mirador Nieves Negras), here we will enjoy the views while learning a little more about the secrets around the Andes Mountain Range.

Participants

Min.: 1 - Max: Not Specified Children ages 12 +

Location and Season

The route is followed through a great part of the Cajon del Maipo, coming very close to the border with Argentina. The starting point of the trek is around the area of the lovely Colina Hotsprings (Termas de Colina), from this place we will go along a 8-kilometer-gentle trail leading us to wide beautiful mountain plains with a full view to San José Volcano and its enormous hanging glacier. Our trek takes about two hours (just one way) considering an approximate 290-meter slope.

It is possible to take this tour only in the spring-summer season, as the access is closed due to snow conditions on the route.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides, will be able to tour the trail safely leading to Black Snows Glacier (Glaciar Nieves Negras). Information about emergency procedures will be given in situ before starting our trek. In addition, short breaks will be taken in order to describe the landscape, to learn about the biotic environment as well as the vegetation level we are going through. Finally, our excursion will end at the lovely Glacier Viewpoint.

The way back takes the same route and it lasts about 1 hour and a half.

CARREÑO VALLEY TREKKING

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

We will start the tour from our Hotel heading east, after 80 km (2 hours) we will reach the end of Colina Valley (Valle de Colina), very close to the border with Argentina where the famous El Valle Hotsprings (Termas del Valle) are located. From this place we will start our trek heading south towards the unknown and little visited Carreño Valley (Valle de Carreño) while enjoying lovely views of mountains rising high above 3,500 meters above sea level. Finally and after a 4.5 kilometer trek we will end our excursion at Lake Carreño (Laguna Carreño), an ancient glacial lake which has stoically withstood the passage of the years.

The way back takes the same route.

Participants

Min.: 1 - Max: Not specified Children ages 16 +

Location and Season

The route is followed through a great part of the Cajón del Maipo coming very close to the border with Argentina. Our trek begins in the area around the beautiful Colina Hotsprings (Termas de Colina). This route is in operation in the spring – summer season or until the first snowfalls come up and cover the access completely.

Summer time: 06:30 am.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides, will be able to tour the route safely leading us to Carreño Valley (Valle de Carreño). Information about safety procedures will be given in situ before starting our trek. Short breaks will be taken in order to describe the landscape, learn about the biotic environment as well as the vegetation level we are going throug. Finally we will reach the Lake.

The way back takes the same route and it lasts about 2 hours.

MARMOLEJO VIEWPOINT TREKKING

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

After leaving our Hotel, we will head to the G-25 route through the area around El Toyo, going through villages, such as San Alfonso, El Ingenio and San Gabriel. From this place we will reach a gravel road to access El Yeso Reservoir (Embalse El Yeso), (approx. 30 km). From the vicinity of El Romeral and skirting the Reservoir, we will arrive at El Yeso Valley Park (Parque Valle del Yeso) entrance, where we will begin our 6-kilometer trek as far as one of Marmolejo Hill's viewpoints. This mount rises high above 6,109 meters above sea level and it is considered to be the southernmost Six Thousand in the world. Our route provides lovely views of the Andes Mountain Range, including views of the flora and fauna that are typical of mountain height. We will go over El Yeso Stream (Estero del Valle), going through plains and starting our ascent following a trail until reaching the Viewpoint (3,200 meters above sea level). After a while, we will go down the same route while enjoying the views over El Yeso Valley (Valle del Yeso).

Location and Season

The route is followed through a great part of the Cajón del Maipo, coming very close to the Piuquenes border crossing (paso fronterizo Piuquenes). This tour takes place at El Yeso Valley Park (Parque Valle del Yeso), a private park located at 3,000 meters above sea level which is in operation non-stop usually from October when the first snowfalls come up and cover the vehicular road completely.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides, will be able to tour this area safely without an established trail. Information about safety procedures will be given prior to the trek.

On the route, the surrounding area will be explored while identifying the biotic and abiotic environment, in addition to providing some historical background.

EL MORADO GLACIER TREKKING

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

We will start the tour from our Hotel heading for Baños Morales mountain village. On the route, we will visit different villages which fill with life the district of San José de Maipo. The route is followed through a paved vehicular road and it takes approx.1 hour and a half by van until reaching the starting point of our trek. The route goes along a clear 7-kilometer trail on a 700-meter slope and it takes about 3 hours (just one way) until we arrive at the highest point of our excursion (3,200 meters above sea level). Here, we will be amazed by the lovely El Morado Hanging Glacier (Glaciar Colgante El Morado), a mountain rising above 4.600 meters above sea level.

The way back takes the same route and it lasts 2 hours.

Participants

Min.: 1 - Max: Not specified Children ages 16 +

Location and Season

El Morado Hanging Glacier (Glaciar Colgante El Morado) is located in the Arenas Park at 3,200 meters above sea level. You can visit this place throughout the year, provided ice conditions are safe.

In winter, we can take this tour wearing snowshoes.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides, will be able to tour this area safely and following the paths established by the area administrators. Infomation about safety procedures will be given prior to the trek.

On the route, the surrounding area will be explored while identifying and characterizing the existing biotic and abiotic environment.

DARWIN ROUTE HORSEBACK RIDE

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

As soon as we leave Las Majadas Hotel, we will head for the G-25 route through the vicinity of El Toyo, going through villages, such as San Alfonso, El Ingenio and San Gabriel. From here we will reach a gravel road to go into El Yeso Reservoir (Embalse El Yeso) (approx. 30 km). From the area around El Romeral and skirting the Reservoir, we will access El Yeso Valley Park (Parque Valle El Yeso) entrance where our horses will be waiting for us. Once we go through El Yeso Stream (Estero El Yeso) and plains, we will begin a dizzy ascent through the mythical Piuquenes Passage (Paso Piuquenes) at 4.0000 meters above sea level.

Location and Season

The route is followed through a great part of the Cajón del Maipo, until we reach El Yeso Park, (Parque El Yeso), a private park located at 3,000 meters above sea level. This park is in operation non-stop usually from October when the first snowfalls come up and cover the vehicular road completely.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides and muleteers with enough mountain experience, will be able to tour this area safely. Information about safety procedures will be given prior to the horseback ride.

On the route, the surrounging area will be explored while identifying the biotic and abiotic environment, in addition to providing some historical background. This place is known worldwide as a mountain pass carried out by Charles Darwin.

EL MANZANO CAVES TREKKING

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

From Las Majadas Hotel we will head for the San José de Maipo village, specifically to the area around El Manzano where we will start our excursion going through a sclerophyll forest typical of the central foothills. After 2 or 3 hours of a medium-high intensity trek, we will reach our destination: El Manzano Caves (Cuevas del Manzano), interesting rock formations that account for part of the geological history in the Cajón del Maipo.

Location and Season

This trek is carried out in the district of San José de Maipo, specifically in El Manzano village, which is located between El Manzano Stream (Estero El Manzano) and the Colorado River. It is reached by the G25 route, a paved road you can go through all the year round.

It is possible to take this tour throughout the year. In winter you can see some snow on the route as well as the high snow-covered peaks which make this path into a more attractive place.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides, will be able tour this area safely. Information about safety procedures will be given prior to the trek.

On the route, the surrounding area will be explored while identifying the existing biotic and abiotic environment, in addition to providing some historical background, such as an existing old Customs Office known as El Manzano Customs (Aduana El Manzano).

MESON ALTO TREKKING

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

We will head for Yeso Valley (Valle del Yeso), a lovely mountain valley surrounded by mountains rising high above 4,000 meters above sea level until we reach the Muleteer's Grocery Store (Pulpería del Arriero). From this place we will climb up along a wide trail leading us to a beautiful view of Meson Alto Glacier, a unique landscape that accounts for the last Ice Age. After going on a 2-hour trek, we will reach wide mountain plains where we will take a break and enjoy the view while having our delicious box lunch. The way back takes the same route and it takes about 1 hour and a half to go back to the van.

Location and Season

The route is followed through a great part of the Cajón del Maipo to merge with El Yeso Valley (Valle del Yeso). We will go into this Valley for about 30 minutes along a paved road and we will end our tour at The Muleteer's Grocery Store (Pulpería del Arriero), here we will start our trek going through Cortaderas Valley (Valle de las Cortaderas) ending in a beautiful plain overlooking Meson Alto Glacier, El Morado Hill and others. It is possible to take this tour only in the spring - summer season, as the access is restricted when the first snowfalls come up due to ice conditions.

Development of the Activity

All participants, accompanied by our guides, will be able to tour this area safely. Information about safety procedures will be given prior to the trek. On the route, the surrounding area will be explored while identifying the existing biotic and abiotic environment. Different types of valleys, glaciers and rock formations found at the Andes Mountain Range will be recognized.

ACTIVE FULL DAY + LA ENGORDA VALLEY (VALLE LA ENGORDA)

DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

We will head for the Cajón del Maipo going through part of the G27 route until we go over the Maipo River. From this place we will visit some of the villages that fill with life the district of San José de Maipo. We will pass by San Alfonso geositio (place of geological interest) where we will be able to describe the landscape and part of the fan-shaped formations. From this point we will head for Las Melosas, an interesting and beautiful rock formation originated from the old volcanism in the area, to continue towards the impressive waterfall known as "The Bridal Veil Falls" ("El Velo de la Novia") and later to the area around Baños Morales. In this place we will be able to see the interesting Colimapu formation, as well as a paleontological area called Lo Valdés. We will end this lovely and attractive tour in an approximate 45-minute trek heading "La Engorda" mountain range valley where we will have a lovely postcard of San José Volcano.

The way back takes the same route.

Location and Season

The route is followed along the entire trail leading to the famous Cajón del Maipo. This tour can be taken throughout the year and it may have some access restrictions just in the area around "La Engorda" Valley (Valle "La Engorda"), due to snow conditions. After our trek to "La Engorda" Valley (Valle "La Engorda"), which is located at approximately. 2,700 meters above sea level, we will reach the highest point of our tour.

The route takes the same trail.

All participants, accompanied by our guides, will know part of the Cajón del Maipo geological heritage, they will go through its valleys, and they will visit its tributaries, volcanoes and glaciers while learning about the history that took place in this district as well as in the region.

Sitting on its foothills you will see William Fevre Winery, one of the many existing wineries in Pirque, being its owners who allow us to access their land having thus the opportunity to learn more about the wine-making industry of the country as well as some of the country life in the center of Chile. Our way up takes approx.1 hour leading us to a plain which will provide nice views of the Ramon Mountain Range (Sierra de Ramón), the sclerophyll forest, the Maipo River and Maipo Valley.


